Nouns in Spanish can be singular or plural. In Spanish, all nouns are either masculine or feminine. The gender of the noun must be memorized. <u>Adjectives</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adjectives are words which describe a noun. In Spanish, adjectives must agree in number and gender with the nouns they modify. Adjectives normally come AFTER the noun.
